January 4, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

MidAmerican Energy Company Customer Service Technician Tim Forsch presented an annual report about their natural gas service in 2015.

The City Council approved a request from Sanford Vermillion to close the parking stalls on the north side of Cedar Street between Dakota Street and Harvard from 6pm on Friday, February 5 to 6pm on Saturday, February 6, 2016 to facilitate the Health and Wellness Fair held in the Lee Medical School Building on the USD campus.

A combined election agreement with Clay County and the Vermillion Public School District for the June 7, 2016 election was approved.

The 2016 payroll resolution for City Council members, Board and Commission members and city employees was approved.
