### **October 3, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary**

Proclamations recognizing both Public Power Week and Fire Prevention Week 2016 were read.

A special permit to exceed permissible sound levels by no more than 50% and a permit for consumption but not sale of alcohol for the Vermillion Area Farmers Market on the fairgrounds east of High Street and south of Cherry Street on Thursday, October 27, 2016 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. were both approved.

A request to close Rose Street from 3:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on October 7, 2016 for multiple events at the Dakota Dome and Sanford Coyote Sports Center was approved.

A transmission facilities assignment agreement with Missouri River Energy Services was approved.

A resolution for a funding agreement with South Dakota Department of Transportation for the design and construction of a shared use path was adopted.

A resolution to adjust the storm water drainage fee was adopted.
