February 16, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

The City Council adopted a resolution approving the annexation of the airport property.

The City Council authorized a resolution to notify Clay-Union Electric Cooperative of the intent to serve the newly annexed airport property with city electrical service.

The City Council approved the Final Plat of Lots 3A, 3B, and 4A in Block 1, and Lot 2A and 2B in Block 4, and a portion of Janklow Court in Outlot B of French East Addition.

The City Council reviewed a lease abatement request from SBA Communications for a tower lease on E. Highway 50. This item was continued from the February 1st meeting. Action was tabled until the March 21st meeting to provide additional time for the company to respond.

The City Council adopted a resolution authorizing the purchase of one electrical padmount switch from the City of Moorhead, MN bid.

The City Council passed a resolution approving easements along 316th Street and 456th Avenue for a transmission line to the proposed electrical substation to be constructed on Lot 1, Block 1 of the Heikes Addition.

City Manager Report Notes

A special City Council meeting on Monday, February 29th at 5:15 pm at the Fire Station, 820 N. Dakota St., is being planned to consider bids to construct the Prentis Park pool and review the 2015 Fire Department annual report.

Reminder that Kidder Street will be closed on Saturday, February 27th from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the Special Olympics Polar Plunge. Kidder Street will be closed for one-half of a block from Court Street to the alley opening to the west.

The City of Vermillion is seeking a group of volunteers for the Paint SD program. Volunteers would help paint a single family, owner occupied residence for an owner that is physically or financially unable to paint. SD Housing Authority would supply the paint. Applications are due by April 1st. The event would take place during a weekend of June 2016.
