### **March 7, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary**

A proclamation recognizing Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Month was made.

The City Finance Officer presented the unaudited 2015 Annual Financial Report.

The City Council authorized a resolution to purchase one Toro turf sprayer for the Bluffs Golf Course through the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance.

The City Council appointed Rich Holland, Katherine Price and Steve Ward to the Consolidated Board of Equalization. The board is made up of five County Commissioners, three City Council members, and one School Board member. The balance of the City Council was appointed as alternate members.

The City Council awarded three bids to Vermillion Ford. The first two bids are for pickups to be used by the Curbside Recycling program and Fire/EMS Department. The third bid is for a Ford Explorer AWD Police Utility vehicle.

A bid from Dalsin, Inc. of Sioux Falls to replace the roof on the lower portion of the 820 N. Dakota Street Fire Station and at the animal shelter was accepted.

A bid for 10,000 feet of electric wire and 23 padmount transformers in seven different sizes was awarded.

A bid from North Central International of Sioux Falls for a Street Department dump truck chassis was accepted.

### **City Manager Report Notes**

Raffle notifications:

American Indian Science and Engineering Society will be selling \$1 tickets during the annual USD Pow Wow on March 19, 2016. It is a 50/50 drawing with the proceeds split between the winning tickets and AISES. AISES use the tickets proceeds to help offset travel cost for the national convention held every November.

Vermillion High School Seniors are selling \$10 raffle tickets from March 4-20, 2016. There are three prizes: a 39" Vizio tv, framed print from Tigert Art gallery, and 18 holes of golf and cart for four people at the Bluffs. Top prize is valued at \$250. The drawing will be on March 21<sup>st</sup>. Proceeds from the raffle will be used to help the High School Seniors pay for their class trip to Kansas City / Worlds of Fun.
