June 20, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

Permission to exceed permissible sound levels for Vermillion Fire/EMS Department for July 4th Community Day in the Park events at Barstow Park from 3 p.m. to 10 p.m. was approved.

The City Council approved first reading of Ordinance 1343 to modify standards for electrical substations. Fencing will be required as needed to secure a substation and screening is required for any side that abuts a residential zoning district.

First reading of a Joint Zoning amendment to establish Aquifer Protection Overlay Zone A was approved. The second reading of the ordinance will be at a Joint meeting with the Clay County Commission scheduled for Monday, June 27th at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.

The closing of Plum Street from E. Cherry Street to Highway 50 and Rose Street from Coyote Village to the Dakota Dome from 5 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, August 19, 2016 for the University of South Dakota's Move-In Day was approved.

Sandra Brown was reappointed to the Vermillion Housing Authority Board for a 5-year term.

A resolution to prepay a portion of a 2015 Special Assessment bond to reduce future interest costs as property owner payments were received was approved.

\$2,500 of funding from the City's Bed, Board and Booze fund and up to \$10,000 of funding from Business Improvement District #1 was approved to support the VCDC's Sports Authority in their efforts to host the events for the SD High School All-Star Football game.

A contract in the amount of \$29,186 was awarded to M&M Construction of Vermillion to improve storm water drainage along Burbank Road from S. Crawford Road to Natalie Court. M&M Construction was also awarded a contract for \$31,151.71 for miscellaneous concrete repairs around the city and at City facilities.

City Manager Report Notes

Free tire disposal for Vermillion and Clay County residents at the landfill during normal business hours ends with the close of business on Friday, June 24, 2016.

The City is going street by street picking up storm related tree debris. Residents are asked to place the tree branches at the curb away from utility boxes, street lights and trees.

The Governor announced that Vermillion has received a \$515,000 CDBG award to assist with funding the Prentis Street sanitary sewer lift station project which will begin in 2017.

City Offices will be closed on Monday, July 4th for the holiday. The first City Council meeting of July is on Tuesday, July 5.

Greening Vermillion will begin their first round of storm sewer inlet painting on June 25th. A number of inlets will be marked with a fish symbol and the message "Dump No Waste – Drains to River". The markings are designed to remind the public where storm water is finally deposited and assist the City to comply with Federal storm water regulations.
