June 6, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

Special permission to exceed permissible sound levels, a special daily malt beverage and wine license, and a street closure request for Vermillion Area Chamber of Commerce and Development Company for "Thursdays on the Platz" events from 5:30pm to 8pm on or about July 21, August 4, August 18, and September 1, 2016 with rain dates of July 28, August 11, August 25 and September 8, 2016 on Ratingen Platz and the half block of Market Street south of W. Main Street were all approved.

The Street Department's 2016 Chip Seal Project bid was awarded to Topkote for the amount of \$79,219.08. The work is scheduled to be completed by the end of August 2016.

The service territory transfer agreement with Clay Union Electric for customers at the airport and the related costs for the transfer were approved.

A fireworks public display permit for the field between Wal-Mart and Polaris submitted by the Vermillion Chamber of Commerce and Development Company for July 4, 2016 was approved. The display is scheduled to start at approximately 10pm.

A resolution maintaining the City of Vermillion's current financial position for Joint Powers as the City of Yankton considers single stream recycling was approved.

A special meeting date to canvass city election results was set for June 13 at Noon.

A resolution amending a resolution authorizing the purchase of a Toro turf sprayer was approved.

Bid openings for Bliss Pointe park playground equipment and fuel quotes were both approved. The playground installation is scheduled to be completed by August 20, 2016.

City Manager Report Notes

The Prentis Park pool is open through July 31 as weather permits.

Free tire disposal for Vermillion and Clay County residents is currently available at the landfill during normal business hours. This will likely only last a couple more weeks.

Expressions of Interest forms are due June 17, 2016 at noon for an expiring five-year term on the Vermillion Housing Authority Board.

Mosquito spraying will commence on June 13 and end on June 17 and will take place from 9pm to 1am, weather permitting. The internal areas of Prentis and Lions Park will be sprayed on June 8 after 9pm, weather permitting. If a property owner does not want the spraying to take place as the equipment passes their property, they are asked to contact City Hall at 677-7050 to be placed on the "No Spray" list.

E. Main Street will be closed between Plum and Sycamore Street on June 9, 10 and 11 from 7pm to approximately 9:30pm and June 12 from 4pm to approximately 6:30pm for the Shakespeare Festival productions at Prentis Park.
