September 19, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

A proclamation recognizing National Senior Center Month was read.

A resolution approving the special assessment roll and notice of special assessments for nuisance abatement was adopted.

A street closure request and a special permit to exceed permissible sound levels by no more than 50% for the USD Dakota Days Executive Board's Vermtown Bash street dance on October 5, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Ratingen Platz and portions of Market and Main Streets were both approved.

A street closure request and a special permit to exceed permissible sound levels by no more than 50% for the USD Sorority & Fraternity Life's Greek Life Awards Ceremony on September 23, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Cedar Street between Plum and Pine Streets were both approved.

The second readings of Ordinance 1345 – a Cable Franchise Agreement with MIDCO, Ordinance 1346 – the 2017 Appropriations, and Ordinance 1347 – the revised 2016 Appropriations, were each approved.

A transfer of used Fire Department SCBA equipment and helmets to Volin, Gayville, and Centerville Fire Departments was approved.

Greg Redlin was appointed to the balance of a Library Board term and Clarence Pederson was reappointed to the Tree Board.

An airport hangar lease assignment from Grant Fluent to Dave Howard was approved.

A bid opening for 20 sets of new Fire Department turnout gear was approved.
