September 6, 2016 City Council Meeting Summary

A proclamation recognizing National Arts in Education Week was read.

A proclamation recognizing Direct Support Professionals Recognition Week was read.

A special daily malt beverage and wine license, a special permit to exceed permissible sound levels from 5 pm until 11 pm, and a street closure request for W. Main Street from Prospect Street to the alley way between Mead Lumber Company and CorTrust Bank and Market Street from W. Main Street south one half block from 4 pm until 11 pm for the 2nd Annual OktoberFest celebration, hosted by the Vermillion Area Chamber of Commerce and Development Company, on or about Friday, September 30 and Saturday, October 1, 2016 were all approved.

The first reading of Ordinance 1345, a Cable Franchise Agreement with MIDCO, was approved.

An agreement with FOP #19 for 2016-2018 for eligible Police Department employees was approved.

The annual use of malt beverage markup receipts collected, a proposal to use the funding during the 2017 budget year, and public input on the continuation of the wholesale license fee was reviewed.

The first reading of Ordinance 1346, the 2017 Appropriations, was approved.

The first reading of Ordinance 1347, the revised 2016 Appropriations, was approved.

The final plat of Lot 1, Block 1, the Chadima Addition, was approved.

The final documents for the 115kV Substation Improvements Project were approved.

A resolution authorizing the application for a DENR Grant/Loan for the purchase of a Landfill Dozer was adopted.

A permit for consumption but not sale on Friday, September 16, 2016 from 7 pm to 9 pm for the "Books & Brews" event at the Edith B. Siegrist Vermillion Public Library, 18 Church Street, was approved.

A resolution fixing the time and place for a hearing and notice of hearing to levy special assessments for nuisance abatements was adopted.
