JANUARY 3, 2023 CITY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY:

A proclamation recognizing Monday, January 16, 2023 as the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr Day of Service was read.

The second reading of Ordinance 1477 to amend City Code to provide a definition for Brewpub, Farm Winery, Micro Brewery, and Wine Manufacturer and to provide for the uses to be a Conditional Use or Permitted Use in the Central Business District, General Business District, and General Industrial District was approved.

The first reading of Ordinance 1478 amending City code Section 90.01 to provide consistency between the verbiage and corresponding hours on the related chart was approved. Section 90.01 regulates the maximum noise levels that may be generated at different times of the day. The allowable noise levels are not changing.

Change order number 4 for the Highway 50 drainage improvements completed in 2021 was approved. Approval of this change order did not increase the project cost but was a closeout procedure related to the State funding of the project. Final payment was made on the project in January 2022.

The 2023 payroll resolution setting wages and salaries for all City Council members and employees was approved.

A motion to transfer a 2015 taser from the Police Department to the Clay County, SD Sheriff's Office was approved.

City Manager's Report:

The City's Christmas Tree collection site is open and accepts real trees. The site is located on the south side of Broadway just west of Dakota Street. Please remove any plastic that you might wrap the tree in for transporting the tree as well as lights and decorations. Live Christmas trees will be accepted at the site through Friday, January 13, 2023.

City offices will be closed on Monday, January 16, 2023 for the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. The next regular City Council meeting is on Tuesday, January 17, 2023.
