February 3, 2020 City Council Meeting Summary

A proclamation for LOVermillion Day, Thursday, February 13, 2020 was read.

The second reading of Ordinance 1411 and Ordinance 1412 were approved. Adoption of these ordinances amend the adopted 2018 version of the International Building Code and the adopted version of the 2018 version of the International Residential Code to add roofing and siding as work requiring a permit. A resolution adopting fees for roofing and siding permits was adopted. The resolution set a roofing or siding or window permit at \$25.

The City Council approved adopting a Home Rule Committee. Interested residents for the five-member Committee are asked to complete an Expression of Interest form and return it to City Hall by Noon on Thursday, February 27, 2020. The City Council anticipates making appointments at the Monday, March 2, 2020 meeting.

The City Council approved a motion to authorize staff to accept quotes for an emergency repair of the 6-inch water line crossing the Vermillion River along Dakota Street.

Resolutions were adopted to purchase two police vehicles, three pickup trucks, a utility vehicle, and two mowers for various City departments.

City Manager's Report

Reminder that sidewalks are to be cleared 24 hours after the end of a snow event. Snow should be stored on your property and not on a neighbor's property without their permission. If snow is moved across the street to a neighbor's property, windrows of snow should not be left in the street.
