May 20, 2019 City Council Meeting Summary

A proclamation for Poppy day on Thursday, May 23, 2019 was read.

A public hearing on the renewal of retail on-off sale malt beverages and South Dakota farm wine licenses was conducted and all of the license renewals for the time period of July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 were approved.

The transfer of the retail on-sale liquor license from Brian Engleman to BACT Group, Inc. for 914 N. Dakota Street was tabled until additional documents are received.

A special daily wine malt beverage and wine license for the SD Shakespeare Festival at Prentis Park for June 6-9, 2019 was approved. The closing of Main Street between Plum Street and Walker Street from 6:55pm to 9:45pm on June 6, 7 & 8, 2019 and on Sunday, June 9, 2019 from 3:55pm to 6:45pm was also approved. The temporary removal of parking along the north side of Main St. between Plum St and Walker St. from June 4 to 10, 2019 was also approved.

The issuance of retail on-off sale malt beverage with South Dakota farm wine licenses for Patel, LLC for Little Italy's at 831 E. Cherry Street was approved. There was a license for the time period ending June 30, 2019 and a license for the time period of July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

The first reading of Ordinance 1401 rezoning two housing developments in the joint jurisdictional area from Agricultural to Rural Residential was approved. The second reading of the ordinance will be at a joint meeting with the Clay County Commission on June 17, 2019.

Gabrielle Strouse and Eric Young were appointed to three-year terms on the Library Board.

City Manager's Report

Annually the Parks and Recreation Department offers an informational session on mosquito control practices. An informational session will be held on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 from 11am to 1pm at the National Guard Armory, 603 Princeton Street.

Prentis Plunge is scheduled to open at 1pm on Saturday, May 25, 2019 if weather permits.
