### **June 17, 2019 City Council Meeting Summary**

A LGBTQ Pride Week proclamation was read.

A special daily malt beverage and wine license for the VCDC and the closing of Main Street and Market Street from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm as they abut Ratingen Platz on July 11, 18, 25, August 1, 8, 15, and 29, 2019 for the Thursdays on the Platz events were approved.

A special daily malt beverage and wine license and the closing of High Street from the bike path to the entrance to Vermillion Public Transit from Thursday, August 8, 2019 at 7am to Sunday, August 11, 2019 for the Clay County Fair were approved.

The first reading of Ordinance 1402 amending Title XV Land Usage to add Chapter 157 Small Cell Regulations was approved.

A request to remove parking until July 31, 2019 on approximately 75 feet of Adams Street and 75 feet of Madison Street at the intersection of Adams and Madison Street was approved. The parking was removed to facilitate the construction of the new SAE fraternity house.

A three-year agreement to provide law enforcement powers to the USD University Police Department through the Vermillion Police Department was approved.

### **City Manager's Report**

A home rule study committee is being formed. Interested residents are asked to complete an Expression of Interest form and submit to the City Manager by Noon on July 12, 2019.

BID #2 will host a public meeting about the downtown Streetscape project on Thursday, June 20, 2019 at 7:00 pm in the City Council Chambers. The public is invited to attend.

The Vermillion Housing Authority has a board term expiring. Terms are for five years. Expression of Interest forms are due by Thursday, June 27, 2019 at Noon. It is anticipated that the City Council will make an appointment at the July 1, 2019 meeting.

A Complete Count Committee for the 2020 Census is being formed. Interested residents are asked to contact City Hall for more information or to apply.

City staff approved a Plat of Lot 1 of Block 1 of French's Addition to the City of Vermillion, Clay County, South Dakota. The lot is at the southeast corner of E. Main and Norbeck Streets.

The South Dakota Open is this week at the Bluffs Golf Course. There is a free community dinner on Thursday, June 20, 2019 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Bluffs Golf Course.

A section of Main Street between Court Street and Prospect Street will be closed for several days beginning on Tuesday, June 25. Parking will be restricted and thru-traffic will not be possible on this block while a property owner repairs a section of sanitary sewer line.
