**JULY 17, 2023 CITY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY:**

A special permit to exceed noise levels and the closing of W. Main Street from Prospect Street to the alley abutting CorTrust Bank and Market Street as it abuts Ratingen Platz for the Dakota Days Organization for the Dakota Days Street Dance at Ratingen Platz on Thursday, October 5, 2023 from 7:00 pm to midnight were approved.

Ribs, Rods, and Rock ‘N Roll had three items approved for their annual event on Friday, September 8 and Saturday, September 9, 2023. The first was a special permit to exceed noise levels from 5:00 pm to midnight on both nights for a street dance. The second was a special daily malt beverage and wine license for both days of the events with the size of the area adjusted for different events. The third item was the street closings for the different events over the course of the two days. W. Main Street will be closed from Prospect to High Street for the duration of the event and set-up and take-down. Additional downtown streets will be closed for the car show and Cornhole Tournament.

A request to close Main Street from the Vermillion High School parking lot to High Street and High Street from W. Main Street to W. National Street for the Dakota Days Parade on Saturday, October 7, 2023 was approved. The closure runs from 7:30 am to Noon.

A permit for the consumption but not the sale of alcoholic beverages for the Legends of Delzell alumni event on Friday, October 6, 2023 from 4:00 pm to 5:30 pm in rooms 110 and 118 of the Delzell Education Center on the University of South Dakota campus was approved.

A resolution supporting an application to the SD Housing Development Authority for Housing Infrastructure funding for the development of Baylor Street between Stanford Street and James Street was approved.

A resolution supporting an application to the SD Housing Development Authority for Housing Infrastructure funding for the development of Jefferson Street south of E. Clark Street was not approved.

Brandon Wiemers was appointed to the balance of a term expiring in 2027 on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

The Final Plat of Tract 1 and Tract 2 of Jack Powell Addition was approved. A Resolution to annex the property into city limits was also approved. The annexation resolution was contingent on the filing of the plat.
