**JULY 18, 2022 CITY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY:**

A special permit to exceed permissible sound levels by no more than 50%, a special daily malt beverage and wine permit, and a request from Ribs Rods & Rock'n Roll, Inc to close W. Main Street from High Street to Prospect Street, Prospect Street from W. Main Street to the Alley ½ a Block North, Market Street from W. Main to Bloomingdale Street, Kidder Street from Austin Street to the Alleyway ½ a Block East, Austin Street from Kidder to Main Street, Ratingen Platz, the Public Parking Lot on the SW corner of Kidder and Market Street, W. Main Street from Washington to High Street, E. Main Street from Center to Church Street for the annual event were approved. W. Main Street from Prospect to Center Street will close on Friday, September 9, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. to accommodate portions of the event.

The second reading of Ordinance 1467 to amend Title III, Administration; Chapter 34, Taxation; Section 34.04, amending use of revenue to provide for additional uses of second penny revenue was approved.

A Resolution removing parking on the west side of South Plum Street from the Intersection with East Main Street to a point 375-feet South of East Main Street was approved. Sanford Vermillion requested the parking removal for pedestrian safety.

A request from USD to close Rose Street from Coyote Village north to the Sanford Coyote Sports Center and to remove parking on N. Dakota Street from Alumni Street north to Highway 50 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on September 17, September 24, October 22, November 5, and November 19, 2022 for the Fall home football games was approved.

A request from USD to close Main Street from the Vermillion High School parking lot west to High Street, High Street from W. Main to West National Street for the routing and/or staging of the Dakota Days parade on Saturday, October 22, 2022 from 7:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. was approved. The parade begins at 9:00 a.m. at Anderson and E. Main Street.

A request to amend the Vermillion Area Chamber and Development Company's Street Closure Request for the Thursdays on the Platz events during July and August 2022, by adding Thursday, September 1, 2022 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. as an additional date for the event was approved.

**City Manager's Report:**

The City will be fogging for mosquitoes this Wednesday, July 20 and Thursday, July 21. If a property owner does not want to have the fogging equipment on as they pass their property, please contact Parks and Recreation at [ParksandRec@cityofvermillion.com](mailto:ParksandRec@cityofvermillion.com). The address will remain on the Do Not Fog list for the remainder of the 2022 season.

The landfill and recycling center are open the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of the month. The landfill will be open from 8 a.m. to Noon and the Recycling Center will be open from 9 a.m. to Noon this Saturday, July 23, 2022.

There is a one-year term open on the Housing Authority Board due to a resignation. This seat is reserved for a program participant. Expression of Interest forms are due by Noon on Thursday, July 28. Appointment is anticipated at the August 1 meeting.

Reminder that Thursdays on the Platz began this month and continue every Thursday during the months of July and August as well as September 1, 2022. W. Main Street, Prospect Street, and Market Street near Ratingen Platz will be closed from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m on these Thursdays for setup, the actual event, and cleanup.

The Planning and Zoning Commission meets on Monday, July 25 at 5:30 p.m. in the Powell Conference Room at City Hall. They will be considering an application to rezone from R-2 to L-I a parcel that is immediately west of 205 12<sup>th</sup> Street and located on the south side of the 400 block of West 8<sup>th</sup> Street.
