### **August 19, 2019 City Council Meeting Summary**

A special daily malt beverage and wine license for the Fraternal Order of Eagles on Friday, October 4, 2019 from 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm for the 50 year celebration of the current Beta Theta Phi building at 429 N Plum Street was approved.

A special daily malt beverage and wine license for the Vermillion Area Arts Council on Saturday, September 14, 2019 for the Steampunk Pirate Festival at 202 Washington Street was approved.

A resolution approving a grant offer for the Airport Improvement Program for the design engineering for design reconstruction of the hangar taxiway with the FAA was approved.

Michelle Maloney was appointed to a three-year term on the BID #2 Board.

A resolution fixing September 16, 2019 at 7:00 pm as the time and place for a hearing on the Special Assessment Roll for Nuisance Abatement was approved. The special assessment roll is for unpaid grass tagging, snow tagging, and the work to correct these violations.
