

## Recreational Outdoor Fire Ordinance (Fire pits)

(C) Recreational outdoor fire burning materials, other than rubbish, that are enclosed and have a total fuel area of 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height for the purpose of pleasure, religious, cooking, warmth, or similar purpose are permitted. (1975 Code, § 10-27) (Ord. 597, passed 3-5-1973)

(D) A recreational fire or bonfire shall be constantly attended until such fire has been extinguished. A fire extinguisher or garden hose shall be available for immediate utilization if needed. (1975 Code, § 10-28)

(E) The Fire Chief or his/her designee shall have the authority to order extinguishment of any fire because such fire becomes hazardous to property or public health.
